Concessions- Allison Leopold and Alison Heramb

We sold roughly \$1500 in Concessions during the 2021 Boys Soccer season.

Though selling Chick-fil-a sandwiches at \$6/sandwich proved to be profitable for us, we may offer an additional cheaper option for families for the 2022 Soccer season. It was mentioned that hot dogs were sold during a JV Black game this season, and sold very well. We may choose to offer them regularly for both the JV and Varsity games, in future. If we choose to do this, it was suggested that Boosters buy a crockpot.

New Business-Alison Heramb

The Board congratulated the Boys Varsity team on a great season, and tying a school record by making it to the District Semi-Finals, in N. Canton. Though suffering a tough (2-1) loss to Hoover, it was a well played game by both teams.

Other Business:
