May 9, 2025 Special Board Meeting

- ❖ Approval to move \$200,000.00 CTE furniture purchase from the 2025 Permanent Improvement Fund forecast to the 2026 Fiscal Year.

- ❖ Approval of the Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment to an agreement between Cleveland Construction, Inc. and the Riverside Local School District Board of Education for the Riverside Campus Improvement Project at a total cost of \$3,229,290.00.
- ❖ Approval of the Guaranteed Maximum Price Amendment to an agreement between Cleveland Construction, Inc. and the Riverside Local School District Board of Education for the Riverview Elementary School Expansion and Improvement Project at a total cost of \$5,064,612.00.
