10 Straight Auditor Of State Awards

For the 10th straight year, the District has been presented with the Auditor of State Award for its clean audit report. To qualify for the award, the District must file timely financial reports with the Auditor of State's Office in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP). Also, the audit report must not contain any findings for recovery, material citations, material weaknesses, significant deficiencies, Uniform Guidance (Single Audit) findings or questioned costs. Lastly, there are no financial or other concerns.

In addition, the District has also received the Auditor of State's Star Rating System (StaRS) for monitoring transparency in government. School

districts and other public entities are audited and assigned a star rating ranging from zero stars to four stars. Entities that are compliant with all Sunshine Law requirements will receive one star. Additional stars are awarded to entities that implement additional best practices as defined by the Auditor of State. For fiscal year 2024, Riverside received a four-star rating indicating the highest achievement in open and transparent government for implementing five or more best practices. The District has received this award every year since its introduction in 2020.

Congratulations to our Treasurer's Office for once again receiving these prestigious awards.

Ground Broken For Expansion Projects

On May 30, the Riverside Local School District Board of Education, District administrators, community leaders, local elected officials, Cleveland Construction and ThenDesign Architecture hosted groundbreaking ceremonies for the eight-classroom addition at Riverview Elementary and the Career Technical Education (CTE) addition at Riverside High School.

The addition at Riverview Elementary will help solve our large enrollment problems as well as make room for additional students who will eventually reside in the Riverview Elementary district due to several large-scale housing projects slated to begin construction soon. This project is being funded out of the District's Permanent Improvement Fund.

The CTE addition at the high school has been made possible thanks to a \$2.5 million grant from the Ohio Department of Education and Workforce. This addition will allow for Riverside Campus to create space for career education and hands-

on learning. The space will be used to expand and enhance the Construction, Advanced Manufacturing and Healthcare programs currently already offered at the high school. Unfortunately, a lack of space has limited the development of these offerings and we hope to see increased enrollment in these programs as a result of this addition.

Riverside is extremely proud to offer several meaningful career electives where students are able to earn credentials in a specific industry, as well as gain valuable experience in a career field of their choice.

These two construction projects are tentatively scheduled to be completed in early 2026.

In addition, the Board of Education voted in March 2025 to approve an eight-classroom addition and new gymnasium at Buckeye Elementary. The Board also voted to remove the three modular units directly behind Buckeye Elementary this summer.

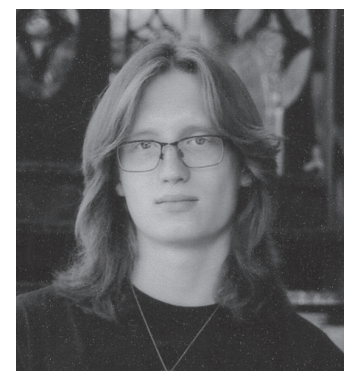

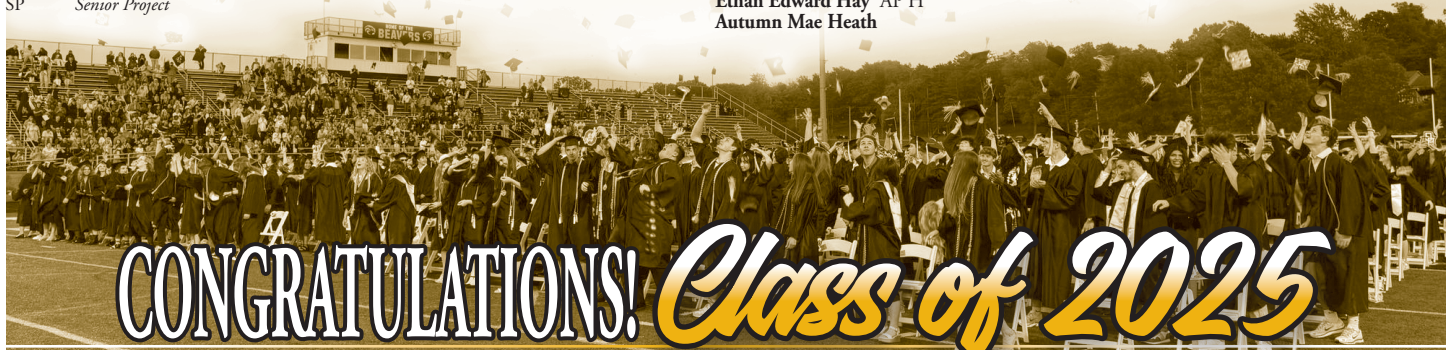
