Minutes

The minutes from our previous meeting on 9/11/19 reviewed and motion to approve the minutes were from Marissa Rogenthien and 2nd approval from Lisa Joles.

Treasurer Report

We started the season with \$13,794.

Spirit Wear a total of \$631.06; Tailgate \$201.26; Concessions \$3,651.26 – last year we made about \$2000; Panini's \$3,192.18 and the year before was about \$2,000; Soccer Banners we paid \$1,260.00. Booster Supplies includes the \$300 we paid for the RHS Sign located in the RHS Stadium. We still have the Year End Banquet that is budgeted for \$2,000 but, we are anticipating going over that amount. Currently, our end of season without the banquet balance is \$16,162.12.

Overall we are happy that we are ending the year with what we came in with as concession did really well.

Other Business

Boys D1 District Game to be played in our stadium. Susie spoke with Football concessions and they will be open during this game on Saturday, 10/26/19 on our behalf. We sold all of our concessions and football still has food available to sell.

In future years, we may have more District Games due to us having the turf.

Girls Coach Michelson stated that next year the Girls will have 8-10 home games along with a PA team coming here for a scrimmage. We could have concessions open for all.

Couple updates for the Girls Team for next season:

- Addidas Showcase in Strongsville he's not sure if they will participate or try another avenue.
- June – they will start training at RHS.
- Youth Camp @ RHS with Cleveland State will take place in the Summer
- Edinboro Camp at the College – 3 days on the college campus. He wants a Mom per room. This will take place mid to end of July.
- Each Girls Soccer player will have one week off from Soccer, if they play year round.

Discussion regarding the Booster Club being split between the Boys and Girls teams. Susie Partin stated as Co-President she is against this act. She wants no part of splitting the boosters as they were created with Boys and Girls being housed under one club. She stated that we should be able to get along to continue to stay as one club. If the Girls want to split out from the current Booster Club then they will need to pursue this and become their own Booster Club.
