Treasurer Report

Cheryl reported that the current bank balance was \$15,675.84. Reviewing the budget, Cheryl had her husband audit the budget as that's what he does for a living. Cheryl wanted to point out that some areas are not separated out. For example, Snow Cones/kick game. Monies from the snow cone were not separated out. Cornhole was a parent who donated and monies were collected at the car wash. Monies are accounted for however, they may not be separated out for us to use as a gauge for this upcoming budget. Cheryl has check registrar and bank statements if anyone wants to review them tonight. We are waiting on a few more details for upcoming events and therefore will vote on next years budget at the June meeting.

ME suggested that we open our own 501(c)3. Currently we are placed together with 4 other Booster Clubs. We send our info into Zappitelli Financial to pay our taxes. We would like to have our own as we think this will benefit us in some areas. One being, donations. There is a \$200 application fee that we will be adding to the budget.

ME also stated we will not be having a Pay to Play Fundraiser. This caused a lot of work for the Treasurer.

Cheryl stated we do have some parents and a contractor who has not cashed their checks. We will be giving them a cut off date on when they can cash their checks as we are now close to the end of the budget, June 30, 2019.

Our current budget will be able to pay for the Addidas tournaments as they have to be paid prior to the close date of June 30, 2019. The new budget takes into effect July 1, 2019.
