4. **Special Reports** – Dr. Rateno gave an overview of the revised facilities plan. Dr. Thompson spoke about factors involved in a levy decision. He gave more information on 1% earned income tax revenue. Dr. Rateno talked about various possible community partnerships for facilities usage.

5. **Unfinished Business** – Mrs. Krenisky mentioned the Vouchers Hurt Ohio agenda item.

6. **New Business** – Mrs. Krenisky said there is some conflict with the June and September meeting dates. The June meeting was rescheduled to June 23 and the September meeting was tentatively changed to September 22.

## **7. Board of Education Committee and Liaison Reports**

- A. Belinda Grassi – Buildings & Grounds/Operations Committee; Strategic Plan Liaison – The Buildings and Grounds Committee met on April 21. They discussed the agenda items. HVAC in the band room, choir room and tech server room will be replaced with the same system as in the lecture room. They talked about permanent basketball hoops in the Field House. They are planning for future vehicle purchases. They talked about a new accessible walkway from the parking lot to the CTX addition, roofing needs, and band instrument purchases. No Strategic Plan update.
- B. Joseph Audino – Curriculum and Programming Committee; Booster Organizations Liaison – The Curriculum and Programming Committee met on April 15. They talked about the CTX Open House scheduled for May 4. They talked about the CPM math program for grades 6-8. It will be rolling out to other grade levels. VR headsets were purchased from Roundtable Learning for specialized training for students. Mrs. Ritt gave an update on student services. No Booster Organization update.
- C. Denise Brewster – Policy Committee; Legislative Liaison – The Policy Committee met and talked about policy revisions with Mr. McIntyre. Ms. Brewster talked about various actions taken by the House and Senate.
- D. Lori Krenisky – Superintendent’s Business Advisory Liaison – No Business Advisory Council update.

**8. Superintendent’s Report** – Dr. Rateno said the Easter Egg Hunt was a success with hundreds of families attending. Ava Passalacqua won Laketran’s Wrap the Bus contest. Her design was unveiled on April 7. Riverside held a Junior/Senior Career Fair on April 10. Laura Poje was inducted into the Ohio Thespians Hall of Fame. The spring musical *Between the Lines* was performed at the Thespian Festival on April 12. He talked about the 2025-2026 banner program for athletics. Forty-two banners were sponsored for a total of \$70,350 to the athletic department. Kindergarten enrollment is ongoing and the Kindergarten Kick-Off will be held on May 7. The CTX Open House will be on May 4. Military Signing Day will be on May 21. Riverside nominated three local businesses for the 2026 OSBA Business Honor Roll. University Hospitals, JEMM Construction, and Fulton Sign, Inc. were presented with a certificate of recognition from OSBA.

## **9. Treasurer’s Report and Committee Update**

- A. Jimmielee Vires – Finance/Audit and Personnel Committee; Alumni Association Liaison – The Finance/Audit and Personnel Committee met and talked about the finance and personnel agenda items. There were ten job postings open through spring break. They talked about the Junior/Senior Career Fair and the Akron Job Fair. There has been more participation in the staffing survey. The Alumni Association Golf Outing is scheduled for June 20 at the Painesville Country Club. The Alumni Association has had no applicants for their scholarships so far this year. A parent or grandparent must have attended Riverside to be eligible.
- B. Dr. Thompson reviewed the March financial results and compared them to the forecast. He also reviewed the Permanent Improvement Fund.
