Fundraising Update - Alison Heramb:

- DQ was best fundraiser for last year. Proposed having 2 DQ fundraisers – 1 during summer and 1 during fall
- Considered 1 big fundraiser – wine/liquor basket raffle
- Shoe collection – consider 2 pick-up dates – 1 spring and 1 at fall tailgate
- March Madness Squares – 2023
- Golf outing – consider early September: Monica Sisa to follow-up.

Concessions - Alison Heramb:

- Increase candy to \$2/pack
- Change delivery time for Coke – earlier in the day
- Check out football schedules and operate concessions for football games before soccer games

New Business - Alison Heramb:

- Third coach – salary payment/School Board approval – need to let Coach Bors know to request on Board agenda
- Summer soccer camp – 3-day, June 27th – 29th, from 6-7:30 p.m. – send via school emails
- Adidas weekend – July 31st
- Preseason get-together after team formation – Boosters provide pizza & parents help with food
- Alumni game – potentially combine preseason get-together with Alumni game.
- Spirit wear – vendors being considered – to be offered after team formation

Other Business:

- Coach Christian: looking into arranging coaching camp(s) with colleges - John Carrol, Tiffin and Walsh have expressed interest. Weekend with overnight stay. Players pay the costs.
- Alison / Coach Christian: Conference patches have been ordered as of email from Kim McDonald on 2/14/2022.
- Allison: has the Field House Banner been updated with the 2021 WRC Conference win? Allison to follow up: it has not.
- Coach Christian: "Meet the Coaches" will be in May
- T-shirts for Summer League, Adidas, and scrimmages - one T-shirt for each player - will be used for all three.
