Each year, students can take College Credit Plus courses, taught at the Riverside Campus. These courses are taught by either Riverside High School faculty or Lakeland Community College professors. This allows our students to take in-person courses, without having to drive to the Lakeland Community College campus.

For the **2026 - 27** school year, Riverside High School plans to offer the following college courses.

Fall 2026 semester

English Composition 1 (ENGL1110) - 3 credits
*College Algebra (MATH1650) - 4 credits
Effective Public Speaking (COMM1000) - 3 credits
Intro to ASL 1 - (ASLI1100) - 3 credits
Western Civilization 1 - (HIST2210) - 3 credits

Spring 2027 Semester

English Composition 2 (ENGL1120) - 3 credits
Trigonometry (MATH1700) - 3 credits
Basic Economics (ECON1100) - 3 credits
Intro to ASL 2 (ASLI1200) - 3 credits
Western Civilization 2 (HIST2220) - 3 credits

*Students must complete Algebra 2 in high school, prior to taking College Algebra (MATH1650).
