### **Fundraising Update – Alison Heramb:**

- DQ Fundraiser is tonight!
- Tailgate was 8/19/22-Spirit wear, drinks, games, and cornhole raffle tickets were sold. It was noted that the Clover machine was helpful in improving Spirit wear sales, as we did not have this, in previous years. It was also noted that we would have sold more Riverside spirit wear Black shirts if we had them. Tailgate is always “Black Out Day” for the student section. Having adequate inventory of various sized black t-shirts (short sleeved and long sleeved) that read only “Riverside” rather than having only “Riverside Soccer” shirts would improve sales for this event. Overall, Tailgate was a success, and sales were good!
- Cooler Raffle sales slated for 9/10/22 (Community Night) currently at \$1315
- September Daily Gift Card Raffle sales currently at \$750. It was noted that our September 2022 fundraising sales were currently down compared to September 2021 sales. The reasons for this are unclear.
- Yard signs generated \$60 in income

### **New Business:**
